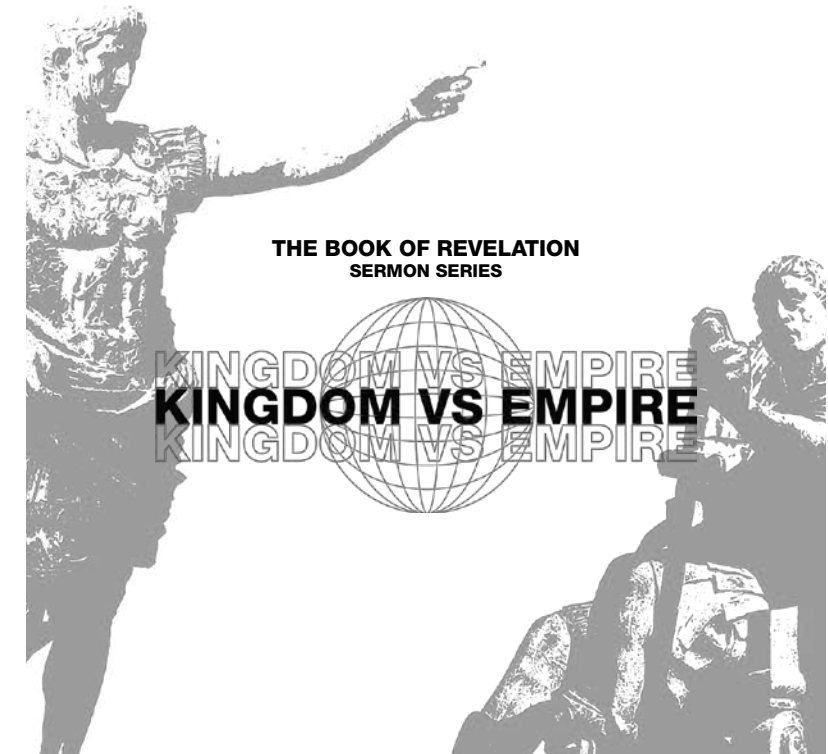

NOTES ON TODAY'S WORSHIP

The Revelation sermon series concludes today with the vision of God making all things new through Jesus. On this, the first Sunday of Lent, our hymns focus on both the cross, an instrument of death that in the hands of God becomes a new symbol of eternal life, and the victorious Lamb who, dying in weakness, rises to open the scrolls of judgment and salvation to reign in glory.

Bel Canto offers an exquisite prayer by 17th c. poet/musician Thomas Campion that God would see us as his very own, and that his grace and light would shine through us for endless days. The 19th c. revivalist song with an onomatopoeia title *The Promised Land*, imitates a tambourine and banjo to accompany believers telling of the new life that awaits them in the promised land of "milk and honey"!

Consider adding a spiritual discipline, prayer, self-denial or even simplifying your lifestyle during the 40 days of Lent to contemplate Jesus' sacrifice and God's amazing love.
