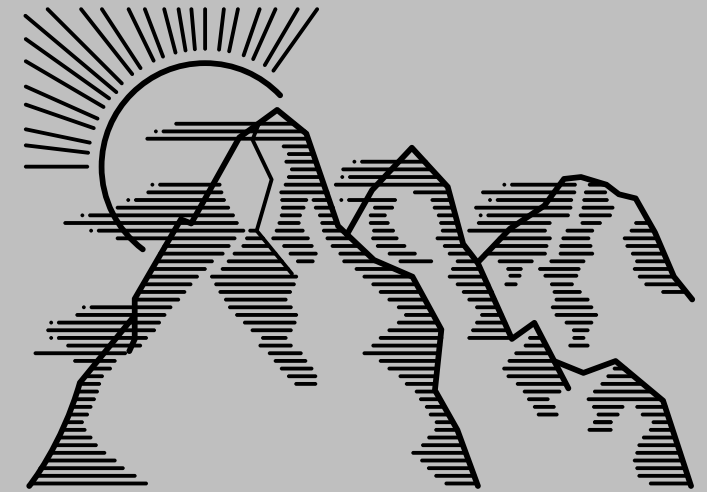

**NOTES ON TODAY'S WORSHIP**

"Njokujabula" (Zulu for "Joy") is from the major work for this spring's Worship Through Music on June 9, *Jubilate Deo* for chorus, orchestra and soloists. The composition is a new, 50-minute setting of Psalm 100 ("O be joyful in the Lord all ye lands") that incorporates the language and musical influences of the world in praise of God: North and South America, the Middle East, China, Africa, and even nature itself! Mark your calendar for this exciting day of musical praise!

In the choral music today, imagine the joy and praises from the crowds on that first Palm Sunday! By saying "hosanna" as Jesus entered Jerusalem, referring to David and David's kingdom, and the use of palm branches, the people were acknowledging Jesus as their Messiah. By week's end, they rejected Jesus and called for his execution.

With many school districts on spring break and families out of town, we look forward to BelPres children choirs returning to Palm Sunday next year.
